From Despair to Love and Life

"I was emotionally damaged, spiritually dead and physically suffering from epilepsy."



Poland

I come from a broken family. My parents- father addicted to alcohol and handicapped mother struggling with depression- couldn't give me the love, care and safety I needed as a child. I wasn't aware of the destruction that was going on in me-I was emotionally damaged, spiritually dead and physically suffering from epilepsy.

After my parents divorced (when I was 11) the situation started to be worse and worse for me and I ended up as a street child, full of anger, pain and very self-destructive. After a few hard experiences (almost dead from alcohol, being caught by police after escaping from home and put into a child foster home) I came to a point in my life where I was suffering so much, not finding the love that I so desperately needed, that the only hope for me to end my pain was to give up my life. I desired to die but hadn't enough "courage" to kill myself. At the time I didn't know God as a person, loving and caring father. God for me was equal to the religion I grew up in- in order to get closer to Him you had to do a huge list of "holy" things (holy sacraments) and live a moral life (obey commandments). And I of course, didn't fit this model so I

didn't exist for God, I thought. But one day, when I was 13, I went to a mass with my mom (she started to look for a relief from her pain in religion) and I opened my heart to a God I didn't know. "God, I suffer so much, I hate my life, I don't want it anymore- please take it and do whatever you want to do with it. I give up."

From that day many things happened. God gave me hope and led me amazingly. He started to be someone real to me, a person who I desired to be closer to. And for the next few years I was doing all these holy things and even more. I was leading my spiritual life through the means that were given to me. In the religion I was brought up in, I was never allowed to have my own, true and intimate relation with God. Everything depended on the priests, because only THEY could forgive my sins through confession, only THEY knew how to understand the Bible and only THEY had the power to do all the sacraments, which I needed in order to be close to God.

Because I truly desired God, my heart was never satisfied. I've always been searching for more and through many years I've been attending many religious events, seminars, retreats and a few fellowships, many times as a singer in a choir. And one time, while searching for God's will in my life, I


This tells us there is room in His sovereignty for our initiative. We shape history with our actions, by our proclaiming the Word and praying, we are changing history.

Dear Team,

In July 1956, a few months after I was born, a B-47 Stratojet subsonic bomber crashed into a storage igloo twenty miles south of Cambridge, England. The plane burst into flames on impact but surprisingly didn't ignite the contents of the igloo. What a blessing that was...because the igloo contained three Mark Six nuclear bombs. Imagine what could have happened if just one of the nuclear bombs had exploded that close to London, much less what would have happened if all three had been ignited! It would have been insufficiently described as... "catastrophic."

Everyday we have unique chances to be a part in averting many "catastrophic" events. To me it is catastrophic for the Polish speaking world to not have a translation of God's wonderful and liberating truth to read and study on a daily basis. We - you and ITMI - are diligently supporting and empowering Piotr Zaremba and his team as they work through the 31,000+ verses we know as God's Word, so thousands of Poles can have the privilege and opportunity to savor God's love letter to mankind.

As Molly considers the catastrophic intent of each of these girls' parents, she asks in bewilderment, "How could anyone think of killing these little jewels?" What a blessing that these sweet little lives have a God that loves them enough to hand pick parents like Paul and Molly to "bring them up in the nurture and

admonition of the Lord." (Eph. 6:4)

When I am reminded how generous God has been to me, giving me parents that used God's truth to help mold my direction in life, I again realize how blessed I am that the catastrophe of an unredeemed and un-directed life was once again averted due to God's love and care.

If we focus on what is important to God, we will all continually be reminded that God constantly gives His people opportunities to avert catastrophes; the catastrophe that it would be to not use our blessings to bless others and be used to advance God's Kingdom. As we lock arms and together do what God has called each of us to do, we serve and empower with a force that is

unstoppable. May each of us be renewed in our understanding that we can make- and are making - a difference!! May God be praised! What catastrophe will God use you to avert today??
